## HUMANITY ON THE WAY TRAINING AND RECOVERY PROJECT FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE IN FOUR CORNERS OF THE WORLD.

Project managed by the non profit making organisation NPA/NGO Association Groups "Insieme si puó"

The project provides the purchase of books and school materials in **Madagascar** to guarantee a different future for thousands of children, helping them to leave the lives of degradation they lead in the dumps where they are forced to live and die due to the extreme poverty of their families.

Restorative programmes for the prevention of juvenile delinquency and violence and social and labour reintegration projects in three juvenile penitentiary centres in the province of **Buenos Aires** (Argentina) are also financed.

In **South Sudan**, support is given to a project for training, micro-credit, agriculture, work and peaceful coexistence for more than 50 young people born and raised in the midst of bloody conflicts and clashes between different tribes and ethnic groups.

The project also supports 10 teachers for a year's tuition and basic school materials for 100 girls in **Afghanistan**, where girls and women live in conditions of profound exclusion - in social life, in rights, and in particular in the possibility of receiving an education - and where girls aged 12 onwards are banned from education.

## **CLIMBING AND ADVENTURE TRAILS**

Project managed by the Fondazione Dynamo Camp Onlus.

The diagnosis of a serious or chronic illness does not only affect the sick child, but his or her entire family. Participation in the Camp offers them an opportunity to compare themselves with others with similar experiences and to experience light-hearted moments away from the burdens of everyday life.

Dynamo Camp's mission is to offer these children opportunities for life and fun and to help develop in them confidence in their own abilities and potential.

Quality and type of service

- protected environment;
- medical care of excellence;
- constant supervision by qualified staff.

Dynamo Camp is a recreational therapy camp in Italy and is home to Europe's first climbing facility that is completely inclusive and accessible even to children in wheelchairs, with qualified staff assistance.

In fact, even children with greater difficulties can decide to tackle all the challenges on offer: from the wall to the routes, from the Tibetan bridge to the zip-line.

This activity is practised in all sessions - with outdoor and indoor facilities.
