IT TAKES WATER TO MAKE A "CIÜF"

Water remains the key element for the survival and development of the planet's most fragile and backward communities. In northern Uganda, many villages and schools still do not have the minimum amount of water they need: this has an impact on schools (it takes a very long time and is very hard for children to get water from the wells because of the distance), hygiene and agriculture.

The project that the Maratona dles Dolomites - Enel supports is in the drilling and rehabilitation of wells for schools and villages, where at the same time, finally thanks to water, communities are involved with demonstration gardens and agriculture.

FONDAZIONE PIATTI

Fondazione Renato Piatti is a non-profit institution operating in Italy (Varese) in the field of intellectual disabilities and autism spectrum disorders. Its 16 facilities between Varese and Milan support about 500 people, many of them children and young people.

The Maratona dles Dolomites – Enel will support the water therapy program.

The water therapy program is an integral part of the individual rehabilitation plan drawn up for each child. Since 2010, aquatic therapy has been provided directly at the CRS in Besozzo, where an indoor therapeutic pool was built thanks to the Foundation's investment and donations from private individuals and providers.

The therapeutic pool at the CRS in Besozzo currently provides 1,200 therapeutic treatments per year for 25 children with intellectual disabilities, psychomotor disorder and autism spectrum disorders.

Positive effects of the element of water on children with relational and sensory disabilities are drastic reduction of motor monotony, improvement of muscle tone, acquisition and strengthening of social skills, improvement of language development.

Water is the ideal environment for a timely rehabilitation measure.
